Updates on COVID-19 in Vietnam, Thailand, Laos, Cambodia and Myanmar – 2 March 2020

Dear Valuable Clients and Partners,

Meanwhile the COVID-19 infection is unfortunately rising fast across the world, **its impact in the Southeast Asia has been gradually reduced.** 100% patients in Vietnam and Cambodia are cured as well as there is no new case in these countries since 13 February. Vietnam has also been taken off the CDC 'At Risk' list in the US. The recovery rate in Thailand is more than 50% and the growth of new cases has slowed considerably.

Governments of Vietnam and Thailand have implemented strong preventive measures to fight against COVID-19. Therefore, here in our region, the daily life keeps going on as normal and so does the travel.

VIETNAM:

Temporarily suspend the visa-waiver for South Korean citizens from 29 February and Italian citizens from 3 March until further notice. No flights between mainland China and Vietnam, no flights from/to epicenter in South Korea and Vietnam. No entry for travellers having visited China, South Korea in the last 14 days. Travelers from Italy and Iran must have health declaration and will be quarantined for 14 days

THAILAND:

Thai Airways and Thai Lion Air are the two airlines which suspended all flights to and from China.

The authorities asked its people to self-quarantine at home for two weeks if they returned from at-risk destinations including China, Italy, Iran, Japan, Hong Kong, Macau, Singapore, South Korea, and Taiwan.

Thailand also tightened their preventive measures at all tourists' attractions, such as:

- Placing screening systems at popular tourist spots such as Asiatique The Riverfront
- Advising visitors to wear masks
- Providing alcohol-based sanitisers and masks at attractions such as Siam Niramit
- Performing additional cleaning and disinfection across public transportation

The Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT) noted that all events, shops and attractions including Thailand's events and festivals planned between January 2020 and March 2020 would continue as per schedule.

CAMBODIA:

Only one infected case and this patient was recovered. No travel restrictions to/from Cambodia.

LAOS:

No infected case. Laos Airlines suspended all flights to/from China and South Korea

MYANMAR:

No infected case. No entry for Chinese citizens.
